What is your name?

he:ʔey kaʔma ho:li:mu

Where are you (singular) going?(ʔa:) ʔahčanhk^hay ho:li:na*I am heading homeward.*

¹ Use __ʔwaʔto ʔahši:yaw after a name that ends in a vowel; use __waʔto ʔahši:yaw after a name that ends in a consonant.
