

## Use ʔayha čahnu on Thanksgiving

ʔayha ‘Indian (adjective)’ (Thus ʔayha čahnu ‘Indian language’)

hoʔkoy ‘to drink’

hoʔkočin ‘drink! (command to one person)’

ʔahk<sup>h</sup>a ‘water; liquid’

čuh:uw ‘to eat’

čuh:un ‘eat! (command to one person)’

behše ‘meat’

čaw:an ‘stuff’

me:k<sup>h</sup>e ‘your; for you’

mk<sup>h</sup>e contracted form of me:k<sup>h</sup>e

čaw:anmk<sup>h</sup>e čuh:un ‘eat your food!’ (literally: ‘eat your stuff!’)
