Scanning Documents on the Phone

Your iPhone has a tool to help you scan documents! Scan a document

- 1. Open **Notes** and select a note or create a new one.
- 2. Tap the Camera button, then tap the Scan Documents button.
- 3. Place your document in view of the camera. (In a well lit area with a flat surface is best.)
- 4. If your device is in Auto mode, your document will automatically scan.

5. Tap Save or add additional scans to the document. After you scan the document, you can make adjustments like defining the corners if the scan isn't quite right, change the color scheme, rotate the document or add more pages.

Tap on the document to open it, and you'll find all of the editing tools along the bottom of the screen.



LIHEAP

There are currently funds available in the Low Income Housing Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP.) This program provides assistance to low-income households who cannot meet their home energy costs. To inquire about program

qualifications, call Lori Leach at (707) 814-4149. If you think you may not qualify for LIHEAP, a good rule of thumb is that if you're getting TANF or any assistance except Medical, you could probably qualify for LIHEAP (if funds are available.) The Tribe's Housing Department also has limited funds for energy assistance. Contact Toni Giron at (707) 814-4128 for more information. If you don't qualify for LIHEAP, you may qualify for HEAP — contact the Sonoma County Social Services Department at (707) 849-2526 or go to their offices located at 1140 Wild Rose Drive, Santa Rosa, CA 95401 for more information. (HEAP is not a program that the Tribe can assist with.)



Rooftop Solar Installer Apprenticeships: The Bi'du Khaale Elder Village will have rooftop solar installed on every house and on the community center. The Tribe has funding through a Department of Energy grant to hire 4-6 apprentices to participate in this process. There will be both an online course of study and hands-on learning during installation. The Tribe is looking for Tribal members who are interested in being an apprentice. **An in-person orientation will be held at the Tribal office on Monday, April 10, 2023 at 2pm.** For members out of the area, contact David Smith-Ferri at (707) 814-4065 for more information regarding the orientation. Free Financial Coaching Available to Tribal Citizens

Since June 2020, with grant support from the Wells Fargo Foundation, the Oklahoma Native Assets Coalition, Inc. (ONAC) has been offering three types of free financial coaching to tribal citizens across the United States: 1) credit counseling, 2) homebuyer education, and 3) financial management (i.e. budgeting).

Confidential sessions are offered one-on-one, by teleconference (Zoom) or phone call, with a certified credit counselor, homebuyer education provider, and financial educator, Felecia Freeman (Citizen Potawatomi). Typically, these sessions will last for an hour and are scheduled at a mutually agreeable time.

Thus far, ONAC has offered this free financial coaching to those participating in ONAC's other programming. Now, ONAC is offering these financial coaching services to a wider group of tribal constituents.

Once the form has been submitted to ONAC, our financial coach will work with you to schedule a remote session by phone or teleconference. This confidential financial coaching is available to any American Indian or Alaska Native in the United States, regardless of where you reside.
